Story/Article/Interview/Review/Essay Publication Agreement

This agreement is made between _____,

Author of the submitted work(s) entitled:

and Women-Connect! (herein known as WC). By signing, the Author demonstrates understanding of and agreement to the following conditions:

1. Copyright and Ownership.

Author grants to WC and its affiliates, successors and assigns a non-exclusive, perpetual, royalty-free, worldwide license to publish all material submitted to WC as a publishing company. Author acknowledges and agrees that copyright notice to be displayed in the publication is exclusively that of WC. Author also grants WC the right to convey re-print permission to other publications, be they for-profit or non-profit publications, WC or other reproducing body, as the case may be reserves the right to post to WC's website. In all such cases, reprinting publishers will be required to agree to prominently display the Author's identification. In turn, author agrees to keep WC informed of changes in email, street and telephone number changes so that WC representatives may easily forward solicitations for contact with author. It is often the case that publishers and other parties write to WC to obtain contact information about specific authors. WC is not liable for transmitting such contact, but will make every attempt to relay such information whenever possible. Having current contact information about the Author allows this process to occur most easily.

2. Client Confidentiality.

When naming a client in an article, all names included in submitted work by the Author will be completely fictitious and unrecognizable by clients/patients or their family or friends, previously or currently known by this Author or any associates. Third party confidentiality will be maintained at all times and in all ways by the Author and the Author accepts full responsibility for doing so according to the Ethical Guidelines maintained by the American Psychological Association.

3. Errors.

The Author will not hold WC or any one of its Editors, responsible for typographical or informational errors in published material. It is understood that submitted works need to be spell-checked and grammar-checked before submission. It is also understood that submitted material may be subject to editorial license in preparing text for publication according to the standards and guidelines set forth by WC, and available for review at any time at this website address: <http://www.Women-Connect.com>.

4. Hold Harmless.

Author agrees to hold harmless WC and its staff, editors, authors, advertisers and sponsors for any and all harm due to inclusion or exclusion of their story/article in any WC publication, compilation and/or derivative. Given the uncontrollable nature of the Internet, if other websites or electronic forms choose to illegally copy the Author's work without the permission of WC or the author, WC cannot and will not be held responsible for this violation of copyright law. Author also agrees to keep WC informed of changes in email address over time, so that communication about articles can be properly maintained between WC and Author.

5. Compensation.

The Author mentioned herein shall not receive any monetary compensation for literary, editorial, artistic or technical contributions on, with, or for WC. Rather, the author is being granted the opportunity to have his/her work and short biographical statement published in the magazine. The biographical statement of up to 40 words will be posted at the end of the article. This biographical statement can serve as free advertising space for the Author, inasmuch as author name, address, contact numbers and website addresses (single URL), but not email address. Other information acceptable for inclusion in biographical statements include types of services or areas of specialty offered by the author, academic or other professional affiliations, awards and a small .gif or .jpeg formatted picture of the author.

6. Contact with Readers.

If contacted by readers of the publication, the Author agrees to make it clear to the reader that he/she is not affiliated with WC or any other product published by WC, beyond the relationship of a specific volunteer article Author. Therefore, the Author understands and will not convey any representation of being a staff member or spokesperson for WC or its publications in any and all matters. If the Author acts in defiance with this agreement, the Author will accept any and all responsibility for any

contact that is established with readers of WC products, and both the hold harmless and indemnification clauses of this agreement will pertain to those customers and readers.

7. Indemnification.

The Author agrees to indemnify WC for any and all liability brought upon WC for information submitted by the Author and contact with WC readers and customers. The Author agrees to indemnify and hold WC harmless for any and all liability incurred by the author as a result of direct or indirect contact with readers or their family, friends, associates, employers, representatives or any other related person(s) or party (parties).

8. Submission Guidelines

The author warrants that submission guidelines provided in the Writers Guidelines through have been read and followed precisely.

9. Intellectual Property.

The author warrants that he/she owns the full copyright of this intellectual property and has complete and unrestricted authority to enter into this agreement. When referencing other people's work, the author warrants that any and all pertinent references will be included with each article.

10. Arbitration.

It is mutually agreed that disputes between the parties shall be submitted to binding arbitration pursuant to the rules of the American Arbitration Association. The place of arbitration shall be Harrisburg, PA; and the decision of the arbitrator or arbitration panel shall be binding upon all parties. This arbitration agreement will continue in perpetuity.

I acknowledge that I have, read, understanding and accept Women-Connect's writer guidelines for submitting manuscripts or articles. I understand that my unsolicited manuscript will receive byline only if accepted and that no payment is offered. If my article is accepted, I agree to sign this legally binding document that states my submission is my original work, and that I accept byline only for my article.

I grant Women-Connect Magazine full permission to run by article at their discretion and understand there is no guarantee that my article will be run at all even if accepted. I submit the following article for review and verify that I am the original author of this work.
